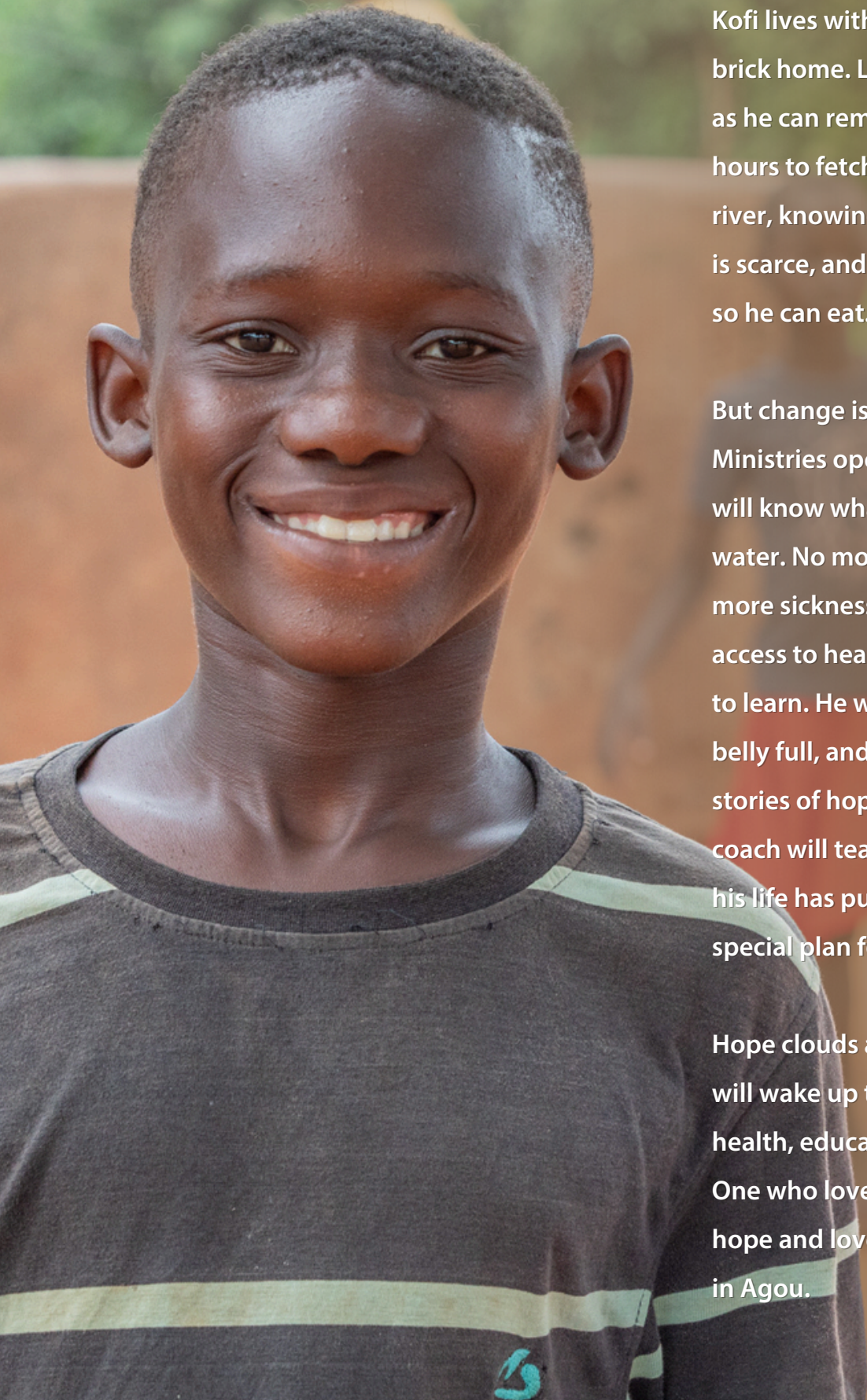


# HOPE CLOUDS ARE FORMING

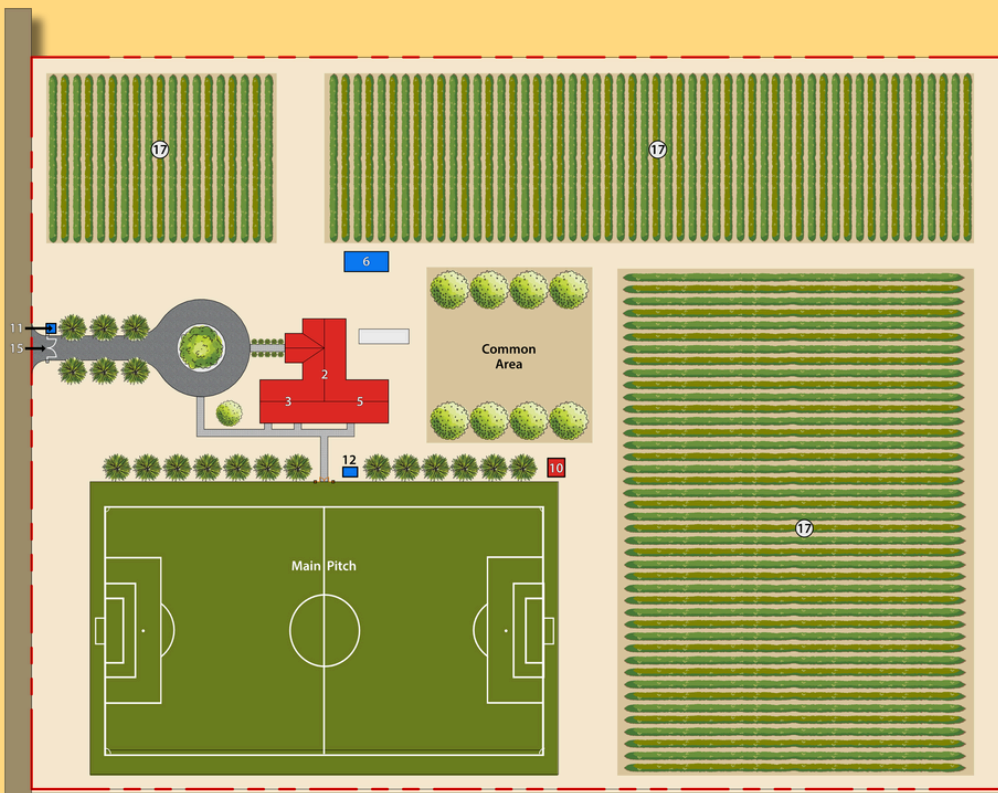

# AGOU CENTER

Agou, Togo, nestled in the heart of West Africa, is a region of incredible beauty and cultural richness, dominated by the majestic Mount Agou, the highest peak in the country. In the shadow of the mountain is a village where life is centered around agriculture and tradition. However, despite the welcoming spirit of its people, this area faces significant challenges. The majority of residents rely on subsistence farming, but economic opportunities remain scarce. Poverty is pervasive in this rural community, with limited access to education and basic services. Additionally, many in this region still practice traditional animist religions, leaving numerous people unreached by the gospel. 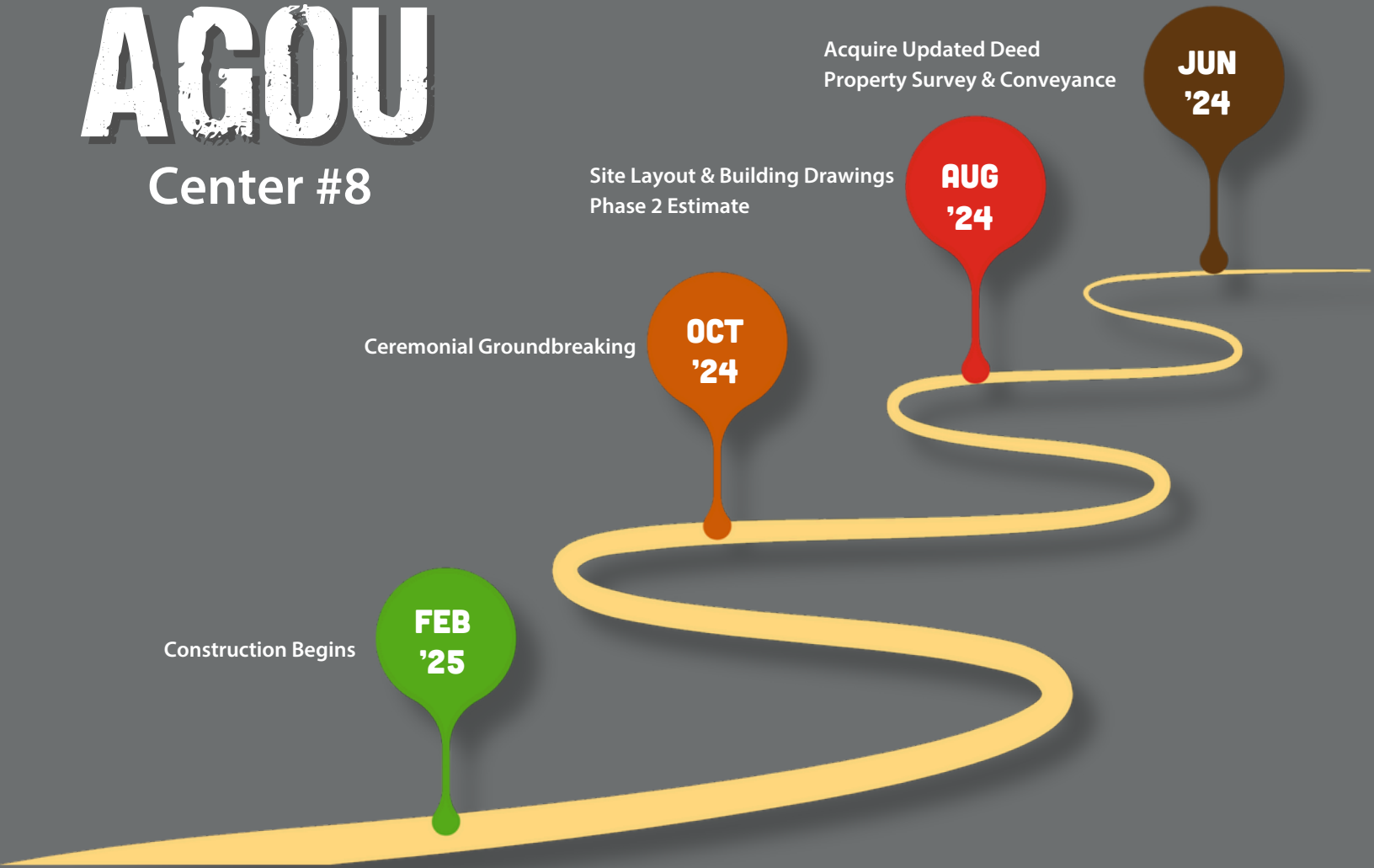

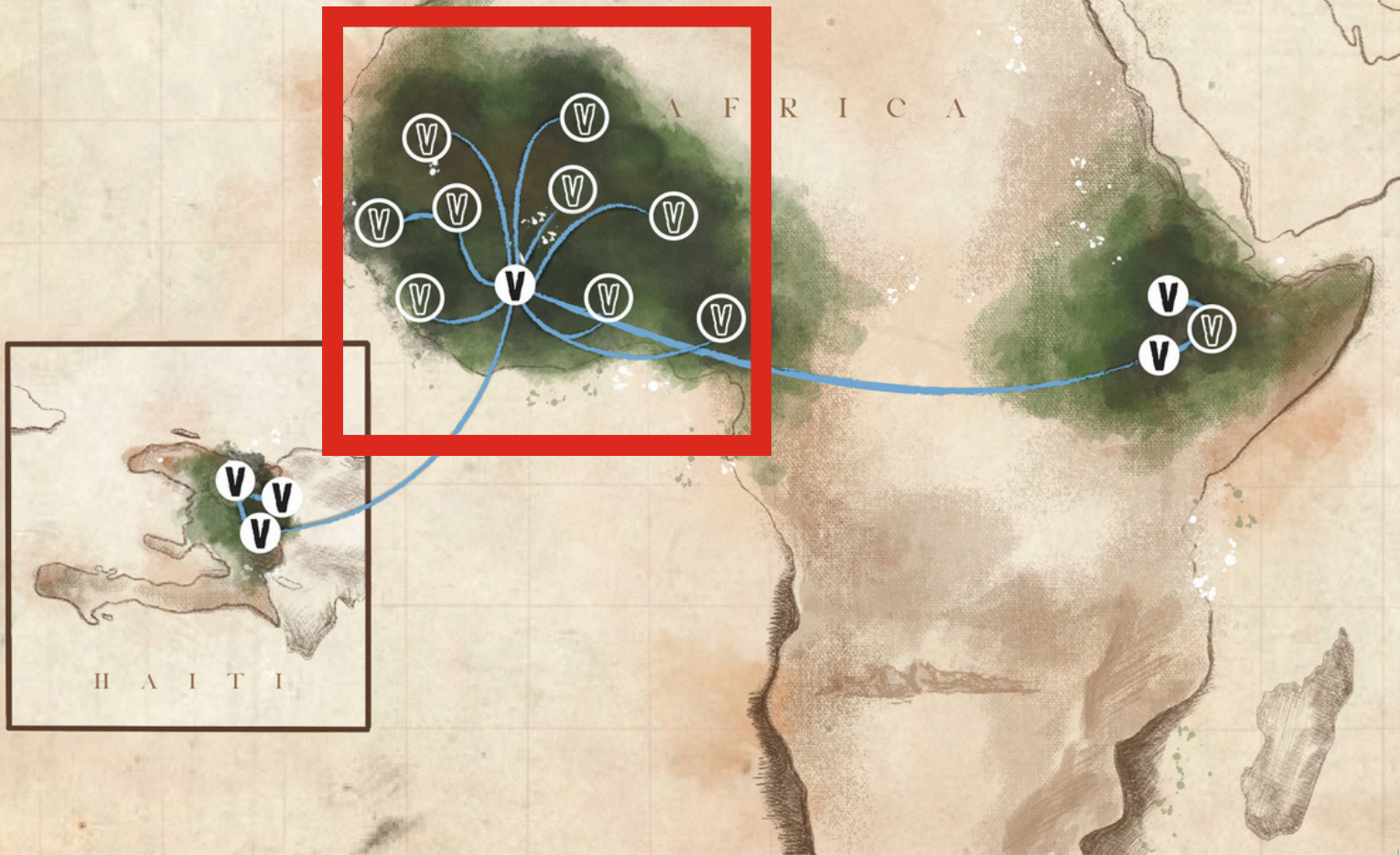
